Notes

- Blue rocks have hammer in the first end.
- Games are 8 ends, and 1.5 hours. Mixed Doubles Rules apply, except teams DO NOT have to be "mixed".
- Never begin a new end past 7:50PM.
- There may be ice time available in the event that a team wishes to makeup a game. Teams schedule their own makeup games adhering to club ice booking policies. Team that had to cancel takes default loss otherwise.
- Competition: 3 pools of 5 with round robin. Top team from each pool advances to playoffs. Teams are responsible for updating their win/loss.
- Tiebreaker is head-to-head, then draw to button if needed.
- Playoffs is 3-team single round robin. Hammer is determined by record, or LSD 5 min before game if record is the same. If 3-way tie exists at the end, each team will throw 1 draw to the button to determine the winner at the end of the final week.
- Any weather cancellations may have to be made-up on a Sunday afternoon depending on ice availability.
- League is structured with incentives: 1st place in each pool has opportunity to win league, while 2nd and 3rd seed in each pool play the most games.
